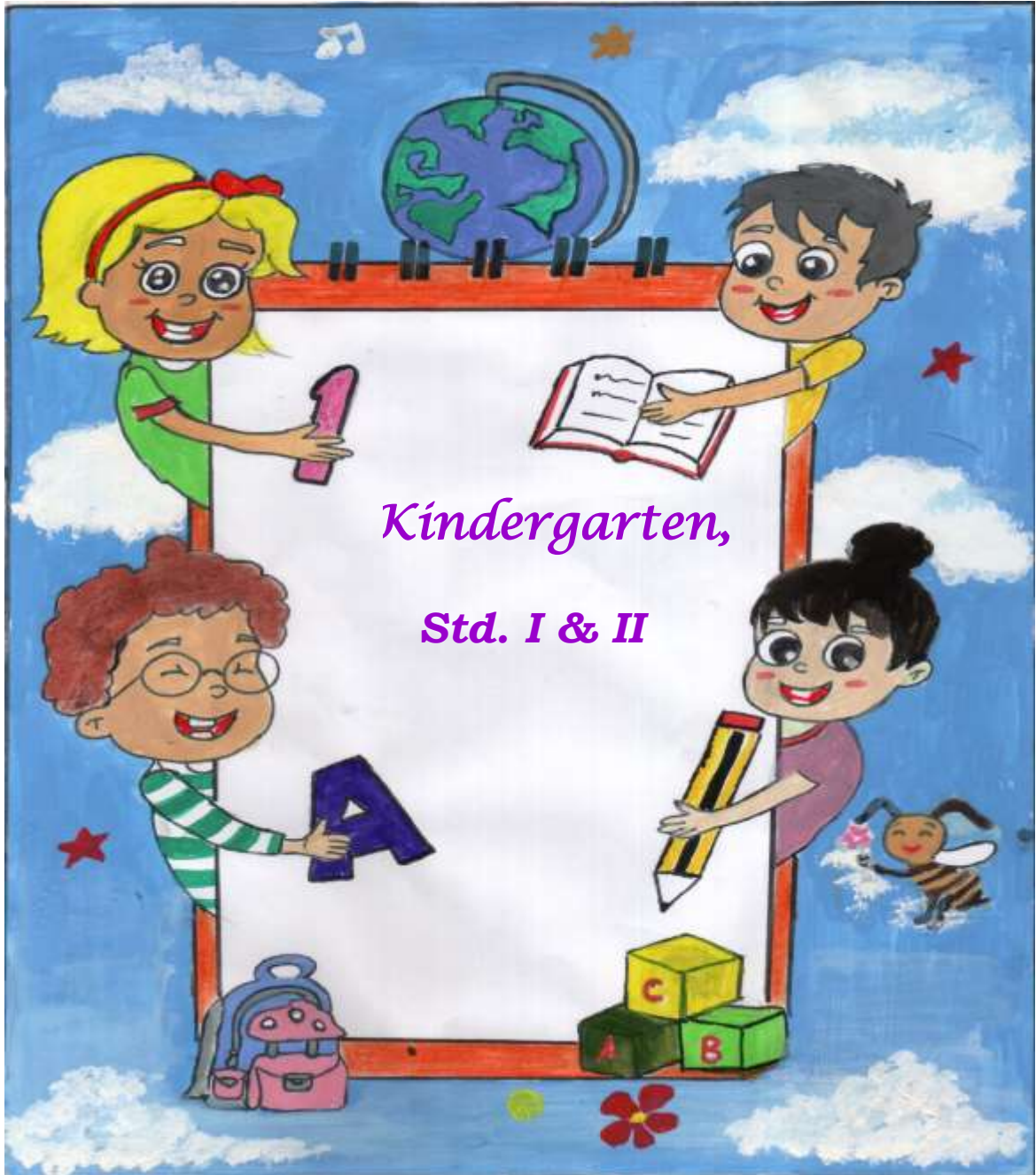

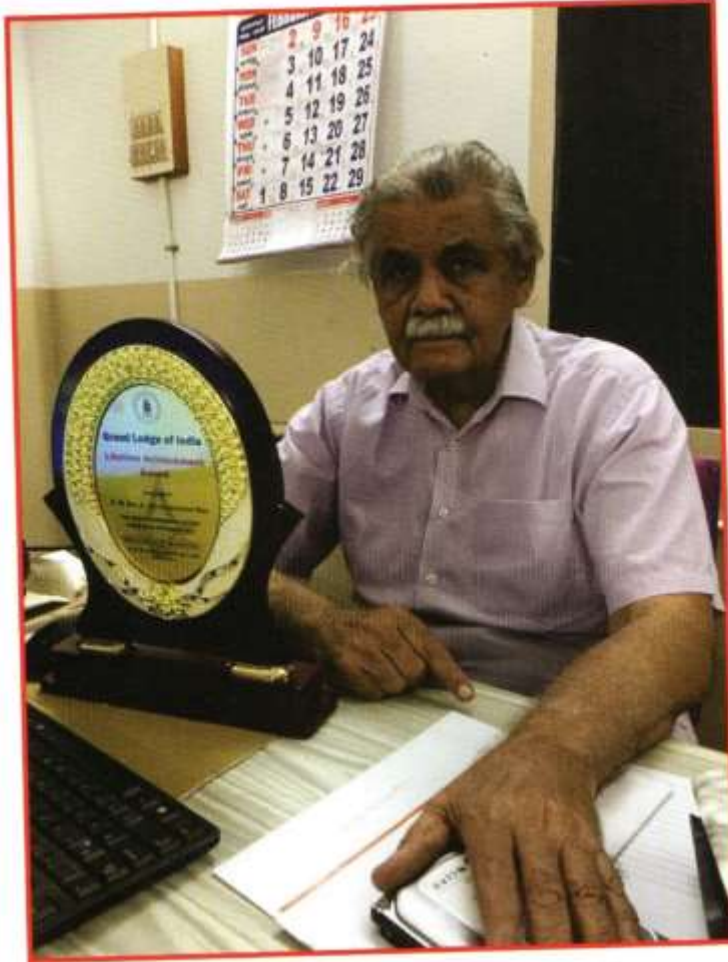

From Our Principal's Desk



Warm and happy wishes to all.

'Be Brilliant' is our school's motto.

We the teaching fraternity strives hard to make every student with all enthusiasm to achieve the said motto.

Brilliance to be achieved in all aspects for which effective support system is a necessity from both school and home front.

A question commonly comes up nowadays is that:



Are our kids learning things a little early?

A prospective insight is shared with you all.

According to ancient scriptures Abhimanyu was born to Arjuna (third of the Pandava brothers) and Subhadra (Krishna's sister). he learnt the secret of penetrating into the impenetrable military formation known as Chakravyuga an ancient defence to safeguard the king, while he was in his mother's womb.

Another story of Ashtavakra also gives us an insight as how kids learn even from inside the womb. When he was in his mother's womb various teachings were expounded to him by his father Kahola scholar and sage.

One day in the process of transmitting the teachings the unborn kid could not get along with his father's version of teaching and said, "hum". He was indicating that whatever his father told was not the way it has to be rendered.



Unfortunately, his father lost temper and cursed the child to be born with 8 deformities (feet, hands, knees, chest and neck were bent). One could see Ashtavakra's sculpted figure in our ancient temples.

Exposure to early learning can have a profound impact on child's development and future success, with benefits like.

- ❖ Improving language and communication skills.
- ❖ Developing a sense of independence and confidence in the abilities.
- ❖ Foster teamwork, empathy and social interaction.
- ❖ Enhances problem solving and creativity.



Here too this pattern of early learning may pose some challenges:



- ❖ Limited exploration or specialisation in a certain subject may curtail child's interest to learn wide range of subjects.
- ❖ Not all children are mentally ready for structured learning at an early age which may lead to disinterest.
- ❖ Early learning may priorities academics over play or socialize, which hinders their overall development.
- ❖ Parents end up comparing their wards with other children who learn early which builds up pressure on their children and bring disappointment for parents.

Children of present day can't relate to world before mobile phones. So, when parents ask them to quit a game or social media it does not work.

Children right from age of 10 years are adept in using gadgets like Android, iPhone and iPad etc...

Parents need to play a pivotal role in protecting their kids from cybercrime, addictive gaming, cyber bullies, porn addiction and sextortion.





Cyber psychologist opines that parents are confused about how much space they should give to their kids.

It happens that parents often succumb to tantrums of children and simply handover the gadgets.

- ❖ Instead they need to invest time to build trust and open communication where the child can talk to them anything and everything without being judged.
- ❖ Parents need to have a family time together without the usage of any gadgets especially during dining time so that slowly the kids would follow them.
- ❖ Parents should teach their kids as how to behave online, where to draw line and how to identify bullying, fraud or other issues.
- ❖ Children addicted to gaming or gadgets are to be weaned off gradually by creating interest in other activities like music, sports or dance. A group activity where they enjoy getting connected with other children.
- ❖ Parents could set an example by practicing digital detox by spending at least an hour or a day in a week without any device.

Looking at the above said story of Abhimanyu and Ashtavakra, wherein they grew up their thirst for knowledge and skill which made them apart of epic.

ANNUAL REPORT KG, STD I & II

I am indeed honoured to put down the Annual Report of Jawahar Vidyalaya Lower Primary (I & II) from June 2023 to April 2024. The Annual Report showcases the achievements and glories of our School. We have always been committed to create an environment in School that helps the young minds to blossom and provide a platform for individual thinking and holistic development of the child's personality.

The academic year 2023-2024 started with an orientation programme held on 10th June 2023 for the parents of freshers from Std I to X. The heads of various departments addressed the gathering. Parents of Std I were appraised of the general rules to be followed in the School. The doubts raised by parents were clarified. School reopened for Std II on 14th June 2023 with 210 students and for Std I on 22nd June 2023 with 156 new admissions. Gradually the strength of Std I increased to 162.

Independence Day was celebrated to remember the pride, the commitment and the contribution of the brave individuals who sacrificed their lives for the cause of India, with flag hoisting.



Gokulashtami was celebrated on 7th September in which the importance of the festival was explained in the school assembly.

Anu found a way to learn the other words which had the above letters. Now she stopped playing and spent all her time learning new words.



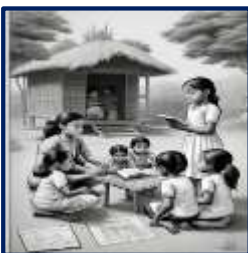
